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Dear Parents

In last week newsletter I sent home our remote learning contingency plan, in the plan we agreed to provide resources for pupils to support their learning whilst at home and ensure that the work they are provided with is aligned to our school curriculum.

We will be sending home Lockdown/Self isolation Learning Packs on Friday this week. These are a precaution and will only be used if children or families need to self-isolate or we have positive Coivd 19 case in school that requires whole Bubbles to isolate. We are sending them home now as this will enable you have all the resources you need at the ready should need to self-isolate. **Please do not open them but store them in a safe place at home.**

Each pack contains a list of the contents on the front and is labelled with the relevant year group.

If you are required to use these resources, it will be only under the direction of the class teacher. The class teacher will set work on Class Dojo for your child to complete and you should photograph and upload the work daily. Feedback will be provided daily, however, we can only do this if the work is uploaded in a timely manner and on the same day it is set. We know that you are all very familiar with this process but are hoping that this will be even better for any Home Learning.

Please be assured that we are not aware of any plans to close schools but are ensuring we can continue to provide the best solutions for your child's learning if they are not able to be in school.

Please do not open this pack unless you are instructed to do so by the Class Teacher. We will be asking for these packs to be returned unopened at the end of this academic year if they are not required as they will be used in future. If packs are not returned unopened when requested a charge will be made to replace the resources.

We are really hoping that you will not need this pack at all but we have learnt over the last 6 months that it is better to be prepared rather than trying to respond in haste if a situation occurs. Please put the pack in a safe place at home, we hope we will be asking for its return next Summer having not been opened at all!
